

## **Plant Sale Returns to Woodside Library Native Plant Garden: Saturday, May 14, 10 AM-2PM**

After a six-year hiatus, the Woodside-Atherton Garden Club is resuming its popular plant sale on Saturday, May 14, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Woodside Library Native Plant Garden, 3140 Woodside Road.

Hundreds of native and drought-tolerant plants will be on sale, as well as gardening essentials and gift items. A knife sharpener will also be there to hone your tools.

For months, club members have been propagating and nurturing favorite plants from their gardens, such as yarrow, salvias, succulents, and hellebores. In addition to these home-grown offerings, buyers will find plants, shrubs, and trees from wholesale nurseries to broaden the selection of California native and low-water-requirement specimens that thrive in our Mediterranean climate. Flowering plants and vegetables will also be on sale.

Members, many of whom are Master Gardeners, will be available to answer shoppers' questions about the plants and their care.

Other features will be

- A boutique with a tempting array of garden gloves, pruning shears, watering cans, garden stakes, and fertilizer, as well as avocado honey.
- A flower stand with lovely planted containers that make irresistible gifts for garden lovers.
- Barron's Mobile Sharpening Service to sharpen your knives and tools.

Students from Woodside schools will be on hand to help buyers transport their purchases to their vehicles.

Proceeds from the sale go to maintaining the Woodside Library Native Plant Garden and other civic projects the club supports.

The event will go on rain or shine. Admission is free.
